



# Sail SEASALTER

*the friendly* SAILING CLUB

### Where we are

Seasalter Sailing Club, which came into being in 1952, is on the coast road between Faversham and Whitstable facing the Isle of Sheppey and is watered by the Swale and Thames Estuary.

The gently sloping beach of sand and shingle is a boon to the sailor and for families, affording reasonable launching and beaching up to four hours sailing on each tide.

### Sailing

The season commences March/April and continues through to November. The Sailing Club sails Dart 15 and Dart 18 Catamarans, Lasers and Mirrors. We welcome other approved classes. Handicap and Class Sailing is the main part of the programme. Open Meetings and National Championships are held on a regular annual basis.

### Training

In-house training is provided by RYA approved instructors and taster packages are available. A Club Dart 15 and Mirror dinghy are used as the main training boats and can also be hired at £5 per session by members.

### Social

Sailing is complemented by social events throughout the year including Fitting Out and Laying Up suppers.



### The Clubhouse

The centre of all activities is the two-storey Clubhouse built mainly by members with the aid of the Sports Council in 1979. The first floor clubroom provides a panoramic view of the Swale and club sailing. The floor includes Race Tower, Committee Room, the galley and bar. The ground floor comprises separate toilets, showers and changing areas, sail locker and briefing area. There is ramped access available to both floors.

### Parking and Camping

Across the road from the Clubhouse is the Club grassed parking, caravan and camping area. The parking and camping plan is displayed in the briefing area for members and visitors.

### Amenities

Shops and other entertainments are to be found in Canterbury, Faversham and Whitstable. There is a local shop near the Clubhouse. Accommodation lists are available.

### Management

The Club has a proactive General Management Committee which has implemented a members own development plan. The Club is run on a voluntary basis. Members are required to do a minimum number of duties per season in race management or victualling.

### Membership

There are four classes of membership:- Family, Single, Junior and Associate with all inclusive subscriptions apart from some social events and Open/ National Meetings.
